If you haven't the official donation envelope, place your donation into a plain envelope marked Lent Event. Your donation is appreciated. *Blessings, Fae*

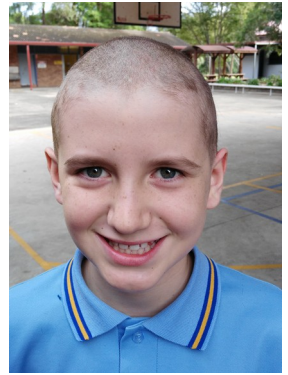
REV. ANDREW WATTS FAREWELL
