The Stamp Committee is requesting applications for grants from congregations in NSW and the ACT for 2018 for specific outreach/community projects to a maximum of \$1000.

CRITERIA: All projects are to involve volunteers from the congregation. Preference is given to projects already up and running and only to "seed projects" if research indicates that there is a strong certainty that the project will proceed. Funds may be used for the purchase of equipment, consumables etc. Funds are not provided for building works, day to day operational costs e.g. electricity, staff costs.

At the annual meeting of the Stamp Committee in September we plan to distribute over \$15,000.
