May you use those gifts that you have received,

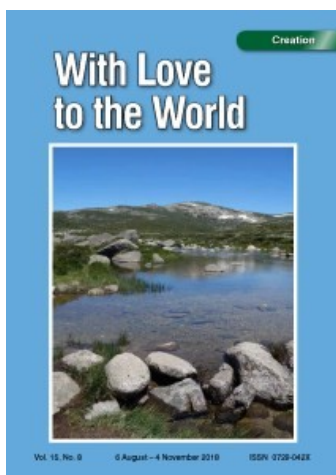
and pass on the love that has been given to you.
