Working With Children Check clearances must be renewed in the three month period before expiry date. A reminder will be issued, provided contact details are up to date. For details on the renewal process, see kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/check/renew

Recent changes to the law:

Everyone who holds a Check is now legally required to update their contact details, including any name or address changes, within three months of any change. To find & update details go to www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/check

Also, parents on overnight camps must now have a Check.
