that all creation will see your glory and know you are Christ. Amen.



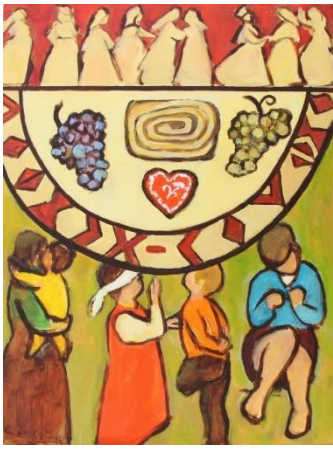
NEWS FROM CHURCH COUNCIL
