A Building Update

The work on our Church and Hall **is almost complete!!** Most of the tradesmen have almost finished their respective work. Carpets and floor tiles have all been laid, the church has been painted from top to bottom and the landscapers are finishing off a lot of planting and the new lawns. The driveway and car park have been sealed, the last of the concrete paths have been poured and the playground equipment is all installed and the 'soft-fall' installed. The new chairs for the hall have arrived, all the builders' sheds have been removed and a team of cleaners has been through and cleaned up 9 months accumulation of dust and dirt. It is looking **GREAT** and we are only waiting on Origin to re-connect the power to the building and are anticipating 'handover' by the builders in the next week.

Some dates for your diary :-

On **Saturday 6th April** we will be holding a working bee to 'set up' the church and hall and to move things back from the storage in the garage next door and from the basement. We are having removalists do the heavy lifting but some things will need cleaning (dusting) before they go back into the building.

On **Saturday 13th April** between 2pm and 4pm we are having an '**open house**' for members of the congregation and our Fisher St Neighbours (who have patiently endured the last 9 months) to leisurely wander though and enjoy the new and refurbished building and have a cup of tea and a biscuit. Other times can be arranged if that time doesn't suit you.

Then looking a little further ahead the Official Opening of the new and refurbished building will take place at 2pm on **Sunday 21st July**.
