Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2019

Justice and only justice you shall pursue. (Deuteronomy 16:18-20)



Every year Christians across the world gather in prayer for growth in unity. We do this in a world where corruption, greed and injustice bring about inequality and division. Ours is a united prayer in a fractured world: this is powerful. However, as individual Christians and communities, we are often complicit with injustice, and yet we are called together to form a united witness for justice and to be a means of Christ's healing grace for the brokenness of the world.

The week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2019 has been prepared by Christians from Indonesia where around 26 million people (10% of the population) profess to be Christians. This is their reflection for Day 1.

Christians can sometimes be very committed to prayer and worship, but less concerned for the poor and the marginalised. Sometimes we pray in church, but at the same time oppress our fellow human beings or exploit the environment. [...] in the Gospel of Luke, Jesus reminds us that the outward sign of true worship of God is acting justly. [...] When Christians work together to listen to the cry of the poor and the oppressed, they grow in communion with one another and with the Triune God.
