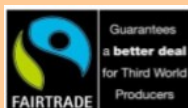

I have found that in times of crisis, a still small voice of calm speaking softly in the wilderness can work wonders in helping with anxiety.



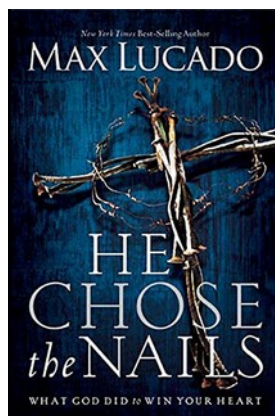
