Coronavirus New Normal

Church Council has approved Keiraview's COVID Safe Plan for Worship Services and also for Meetings. These plans spell out the actions we will take to ensure worship services and meetings are run as safely as possible. All volunteers will be given training on how to help us uphold these plans.

We will need to take names and contact details of everyone on arrival but if your contact details are in our Keiraview directory that will be pretty easy. One of our volunteers will do that for you.

Hand sanitiser will be at the door for you to use on the way in.

You will need to maintain social distancing (1.5mt) and make sure you don't create any bottlenecks.

The offering plate will be on a table in the church rather than being passed around.

People are also asked not to "gather" on the way out.

Combined Kids Club and Good Samarateens End of Term Night:

We are celebrating the ability to see each other again in an Outdoor Games and outdoor Movie Night! Due to Covidsafe restrictions, we will be running this as an outdoor event at Keiraview with certain safety controls, and operating under a Covidsafe plan with social distancing, handwashing and other controls in place. We are in the process of preparing a Covidsafe plan for the event.



When: Friday 3rd July, 5:30pm to 9pm.

Who is invited? All kids and families and anyone who wants to attend that is young at heart! Please **BYO ALL FOOD AND DRINK**. Unfortunately with Covidsafe restrictions, we cannot supply any freshly made food or drink made in our kitchen, nor use our own kitchen to reheat etc. This means you will need to either BYO your own dinner, or alternatively there will be time to walk just down the road to the many good takeaways offsite (but closeby) to purchase your dinner and bring it back to Keiraview. Family groups can share their own food, but we also cannot share food nor drink between families on the Keiraview centre site.

Please also bring warm clothes. It may get cold.

We understand that some younger kids may need to go home early. Families with younger kids can come and go as needed. We are encouraging all and as many parents as possible to come also.

Other safety controls will be advised on the night.

Lets celebrate together the privelidge of being part of our community face to face with our young people.

From the Safe Church Team

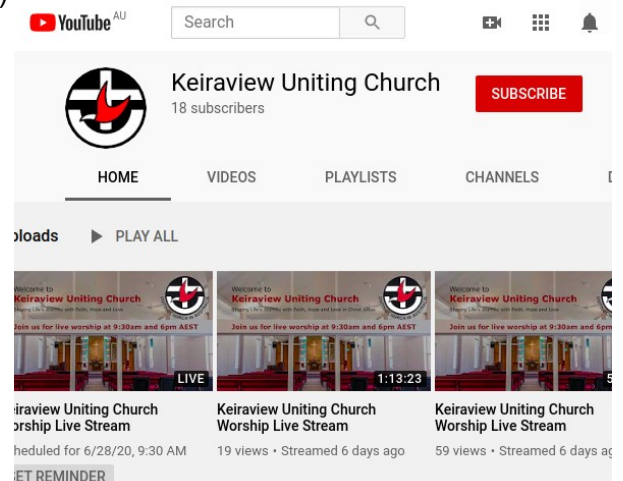
If anyone needs to gain access to the church building outside of formal meeting or worship times it is essential that you sign the register on entry and exit to the buildings.
