Coronavirus New Normal

Church Council has approved Keiraview's COVID Safe Plan for Worship Services and also for Meetings. These plans spell out the actions we will take to ensure worship services and meetings are run as safely as possible. All volunteers will be given training on how to help us uphold these plans.

We will need to take names and contact details of everyone on arrival but if your contact details are in our Keiraview directory that will be pretty easy. One of our volunteers will do that for you. Hand sanitiser will be at the door for you to use on the way in. The offering plate will be on a table in the church rather than being passed around.

You will need to maintain social distancing (1.5m) and make sure you don't create any bottlenecks. Morning Tea will be not be served this week given the rising number of cases nationwide. People are asked to respect the maximum capacities of **each** room in the church buildings and not enter a room unless they have to.


Good Samarateens
