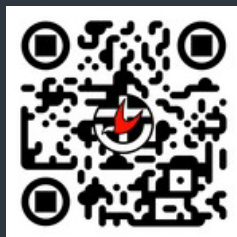

You can now check in using your smartphone and QR code when you visit the church in person.
