Stand Firm "I admired justice, integrity and truth very much in some of the political leaders of the time. I truly wanted to follow them. Then when I read the words of John 5:43-44, in which Jesus speaks of accepting the authority of others rather than seeking the glory of God, I felt as though someone was talking to me directly. That is when my faith changed." Rev Santino is the Principal of the Nile Theological College in Juba, which is currently training 101 students for leadership and pastoral life. He's part of the Presbyterian Church of South Sudan, a one million member organisation in a country which looks to its Christian leaders for hope, stability and guidance toward peace.

"We are currently training both men and women to help extend God's kingdom in South Sudan and beyond. We do theological studies to prepare the ministers as well as equipping leaders to work toward peace."
